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This Cookie Policy explains how Fena Labs Ltd ("Fena", "we", "us" or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit the Commerce Toolkit website (the "Website"). What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Similar technologies, such as web beacons, pixels, and local storage, may also be used for these purposes.

How we use cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to improve your experience on our Website, understand how visitors interact with our content, and help us improve our marketing and services. We do not use cookies to identify you personally, except where necessary for the functioning of our services or where you have provided your consent.

Categories of cookies we use

- **Strictly necessary cookies** — These cookies are essential for the Website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually set only in response to actions made by you, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms.
- **Analytical / performance cookies** — These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our Website. They help us understand which pages are most and least popular and how visitors move around the site.
- **Functionality cookies** — These cookies enable the Website to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages.
- **Targeting / marketing cookies** — These cookies may be set through our Website by our advertising partners to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. They do not store directly personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device.

Third-party cookies

Some cookies are placed by third parties on our behalf to provide services such as analytics, advertising, and social sharing. These third parties may combine the information collected with other data they have collected from you. We encourage you to review the privacy and cookie policies of these providers. The specific providers we work with may change over time and are limited to those required for the operation and improvement of our Website and services.

Managing your cookies

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings. You can usually set your browser to refuse all cookies, accept only certain types of cookies, or delete cookies when you close your browser. Please note that if you disable or delete cookies, some parts of the Website may not work correctly or may become inaccessible.
